

## C.A.R WORKSHEET

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Your job is to make sure the interviewer has an accurate picture of you, your capabilities, and your experience. The challenge is how. Don't panic, just prepare. Fill out this story worksheet for the attributes you want to highlight about yourself. Remember – you already know what they are looking for in an employee. If not, re-read the job description.
